This report is prepared with the full informed written consent of Mr. Colin Paul Gloster.

This is to confirm that Mr. Colin Paul Gloster was admitted to St. Patrick's University Hospital Dublin, Ireland under the care of Prof. Paul Fearon on the 22nd of April 2013 and was discharged on the 29th of May 2013.

This admission included a detailed mental health assessment and an MRI Brain Scan, the scan was normal. During his assessment he displayed no evidence of a major mental health disorder and specifically no evidence of Schizophrenia or Bipolar Affective Disorder.

On assessment, he did have evidence of a disorder of psychological development known as Asperger's Syndrome ICD 10: F84.5. His level of function within this was high. The assessment confirmed that he was capable of work and indeed it was recommended that he return to work and his studies with appropriate levels of support.
